REPORT ON REVENUE COLLECTED FOR MARCH 2021 TO THE FEDERATION ACCOUNTS ALLOCATION COMMITTEE (FAAC) MEETING HOLDING IN ABUJA ON 20TH – 21ST APRIL 2021

This report represents a summary of Royalties (Oil & Gas), Gas Flared Penalty, Rents and Miscellaneous Oil Revenue (Licenses and Permits) collected by the Department of Petroleum Resources (DPR) to the Federation Account in March 2021, as statutorily mandated.

Please find below table showing the summary of revenue performance for the month.

The sum of 4228,340,229,981.40 was collected in March 2021. When compared to 4133,583,283,721.05 in February 2021, total collection rose by 494,756,946,260.35 or 470.93% in March 2021. (See Appendix I for details).

Also, the revenue for the month represents a positive variance of $\pm 71,694,129,632.81$ or $\pm 45.77\%$, when compared to the 2021 estimated monthly budget of $\pm 156,646,100,348.58$. (See Appendix I for details).

Please note that the Department's year to date contribution to the Federation Account is 452,648,809,333.88 (See Appendix III for details).

Furthermore, we confirmed receipt of a sum of US\$222,339,925.97 from the US\$727,978,177.96 expected from PSC, RA and MCA liftings for the month under review; leaving US\$505,638,245.14 as outstanding (See Appendix IV).

In addition, no sum was paid into the Zenith UK Bank Account for Good and Valuable Consideration in March 2021 and the balance on this account is nil.
